## Wiwynn Corporation Raw Material Responsibility Policy

- 1. Wiwynn Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Wiwynn" or "the Company") is committed to reducing the negative impacts on the environment and society throughout the procurement and use of raw materials. The Company pledge to reduce water usage, energy consumption, and waste generation.
- 2. To mitigate potential human rights risks associated with raw materials, Wiwynn will communicate to the supply chain that the extraction and acquisition of raw materials must comply with the UN Guiding Principles on Business and Human Rights, the International Labour Organization Tripartite Declaration, the International Labour Organization's Core Labour Standards, the OECD Guidelines for Multinational Enterprises, the UN Universal Declaration of Human Rights, the UN Global Compact, and the Responsible Business Alliance Code of Conduct. Any form of human rights violations or abuses, or actions that undermine social, economic, and environmental stability, will not be tolerated or supported, thus contributing to the reduction of social, economic, and environmental risks.
- 3. Wiwynn will continue collaborating with stakeholders (including suppliers, customers, etc.) on best practices for sustainable raw materials.
- 4. Wiwynn will increase the use of third-party certified raw materials to ensure that the raw materials used by Wiwynn meet environmental and social requirements.
- 5. Wiwynn will increase opportunities for raw material recycling and incorporate recycled materials into products to reduce the consumption of natural resources.
- 6. Wiwynn will avoid using raw materials from globally or nationally significant biodiversity areas to minimize habitat destruction and protect biodiversity.
- 7. This policy is established by resolution of the Board of Directors and will be amended or revoked in the same manner.
- 8. This policy is effective from the date of its establishment.
